DELPHINIUM, CLIVDEN BEAUTY, 3" - Heirloom, carries graceful sprays of sky-blue spikes in early summer. May require staking. Attracts bees, hummingbirds. Ht. 48". 3" pot, \$4.50

DELPHINIUM, BELLAMOSUM, 3" POT - Tall spires of blue flowers, may require staking. Attracts bees and hummingbirds. Ht. 48". 3" pot, \$4.50

DIGITALIS (FOXGLOVE), STRAWBERRY KING, 3" POT - A hybrid perennial foxglove that lives for about 4 years. Ample spires of crushed strawberry red flowers, a neat, compact form and handsome foliage. Ht, 24-36". 3" pot, \$4.50

LUPINE, PERENNIAL, 3" POT - Spectacular spires in shades of deep blue to purple. These hardy perennials are long-lived and require very little maintenance. Will spread over time. Stems are stiff, erect 12-24" spikes densely covered with ½" pea-like flowers. Attractive to pollinators. Ht. 30-36". 3" pot, \$4.50

PERENNIAL SUNFLOWER, MAXIMILIAN, 3" POT - As tough as it is beautiful, Maximilian blooms from August to frost. Masses of 3" yellow-gold blooms. This native wild flower is excellent for back borders and bouquets. Attracts bees and beneficial insects such as lacewings, lady beetles, syrphid flies and parasitic wasps. YARROW, COLORADO MIX, 4-PACK - Long lasting perennial. 2-4", flat-topped flower heads in shades of red, rust, beige, rose, yellow, apricot, and white on 24" stems. When dried, the color is retained.
